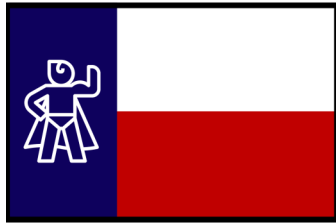

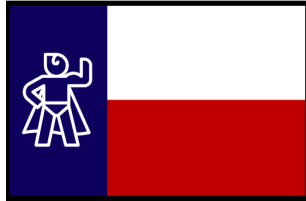

Texas Association of Charitable Clinics *THE VOICE OF TEXAS CHARITABLE CLINICS*

The Texas Association of Charitable Clinics, TXACC, is a statewide nonprofit organization that supports Texas' Free and Charitable Clinics.

TXACC supports the provision of these services through capacity building, education, training, technical assistance and advocacy efforts, TXACC strengthens the Charitable Clinic network in Texas so it can provide quality, measurable and impactful services.

- **70 TXACC Clinics** provided **468,000 patient visits** per year valued at **\$57,000,000** annually
- Services are provided by **2280 Healthcare** and **3,187 Support Volunteers**
- Clinics provide an **alternative to seeking care at local Emergency Departments** saving ERs an estimated **\$281 Million** annually



- During the COVID-19 Pandemic - **86% of clinics remained continually open** to provide services to patients. Those that did close did so for **less than 2 weeks and re-opened** with modified processes.
- **80% of clinics implemented telehealth** services to continue to safely serve their patients.
- **All clinics** connected their patients to COVID Vaccinations either on-site services, or through community partners.
